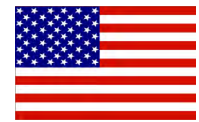

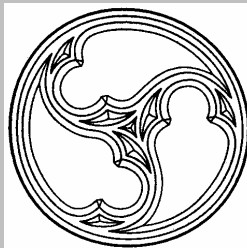

The blessed work of advocating for the sanctity of life and protection of the vulnerable must continue. Special Reflection on Sunday, January 6 and 17, 2021 in Honor of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day

Ald. Robin Rue Simmons Offers Reflection on Martin Luther King Sunday, January 16 / 17th, 2021

During this pandemic the sins of inequity and exclusion and systemic racism have been brought into brighter light. To help us reflect and move toward healing and reparation, we will be joined by Ald. Robin Rue Simmons Martin Luther King weekend at the 4:30pm and the 10:15am Masses.

Robin Rue Simmons is a strategist, civic entrepreneur and has served as alderman of Evanston's 5th Ward. She began her career 22 years ago as a real estate broker. Troubled by the wealth disparities and concentrated poverty in urban communities, she wanted to help young adults build wealth early through homeownership. Over the course of her entrepreneurial career, she has launched and operated a bookstore that offered free after-school programming, a construction firm that employed dozens of minority skilled tradespeople, and developed dozens of affordable homes funded by the Neighborhood Stabilization Program.

During her time in office, Ald. Simmons has prioritized improving the lived experience and expanding opportunities for Black residents. Most notably, she led the passing of the nation's first reparations program, which will be funded by the first \$10 million of Adult Use Cannabis sales tax revenue. Robin chairs Evanston's Reparations Committee charged with working to address racially exclusionary policies, underdevelopment of communities, and the wealth gap in our city - both past and present.

Thank you, Ald. Simmons for joining us – and for lifting up the legacy of Martin Luther King and helping us to more fully understand the place of reparations in our movement toward justice and healing.

In recognition of the benefits many of us have enjoyed at the expense of others, the St. Nicholas Peace & Justice Committee has collected \$1,250 as a donation to add to the Reparations Fund in Evanston.

Join Interfaith Action of Evanston's second annual Walk for Warmth, now transformed into a car parade, and help raise funds to support Emergency Overnight Shelter. The shelter is open every night, now through March, to provide warmth and safety to our neighbors experiencing homelessness. **On January 18, which is Martin Luther King Jr. Day and a national day of service**, teams will meet at the Morton Civic Center parking lot, 2100 Ridge Ave. in Evanston, at 11:00 am to drive a two-mile circuit of the IAE overnight shelter sites.
