From the Pastor / Del Párroco

Dear St. Nicholas Family,

Approximately 20 years ago, our parish engaged in conversations and formation in Liturgy. As part of the renovation of the church interior the liturgical understanding was a key component in understanding the way we offer the Sacrifice of the Mass as well as other formal Liturgies and prayer gatherings. Because so many people have arrived here at St. Nick's throughout these 20 years, the liturgy board suggested that from time to time we place in the bulletin some liturgy basics. Below is an excerpt from the book Our Sacrifice of Praise, a Collection of Resources for Liturgical Formation. It was published by the Federation of Diocesan Liturgical Commissions (FDLC) in 2018 to coincide with the use of 3rd Edition of the Roman Missal in Spanish. Some years earlier the 3rd Edition of the Roman Missal was implemented. Now that both language groups are using the new translation of the Missal with updated resources, Saints' celebration, chants and prayers, the FDLC wanted to share the basic teachings of Liturgy and Worship. Documents from the Second Vatican Council until now are the resources used to produce this Summary. For more information about the source documents used in this book go to: www.fdlc.org. Throughout this year, we will share informative materials to better know why we pray the way we do each Sunday.

What is Liturgy?

It's Sunday morning. We rise, get dressed, gather up the kids, get into the car and travel to our local parish. We nestle into our usual pew, say a brief private prayer and stand when it's time to sing the opening hymn. We follow the usual routine. We faithfully fulfill our obligation.

But what ancient ritual have we begun? What awesome mystery have we entered into? Liturgy is the official public worship of the church. Our most important liturgy is the Mass, but we have other liturgies, such as funerals, blessings and all our sacramental rites. The word liturgy comes from a Greek word, *leitourgia* – “the work of the people.” The work is actually God's work and he invites all of us to participate in it (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1069).

Querida familia de San Nicolás,

Hace aproximadamente 20 años, nuestra parroquia participó en conversaciones y formación en la liturgia. Como parte de la renovación del interior de la iglesia, el entendimiento litúrgico fue un componente clave para comprender la forma en que ofrecemos el sacrificio de la Misa, así como otras liturgias formales y reuniones de oración. Debido a que tanta gente ha llegado a San Nicolás a lo largo de estos 20 años, la junta de liturgia sugirió que de vez en cuando pusiéramos en el boletín algunos conceptos básicos de liturgia. A continuación se muestra un extracto del libro Nuestro Sacrificio de Alabanza, una Colección de Recursos para la Formación Litúrgica. Fue publicado por la Federación de Comisiones Litúrgicas Diocesanas (FDLC) en 2018 para coincidir con el uso de la 3^a Edición del Misal Romano en español. Algunos años antes se implementó la 3^a Edición del Misal Romano. Ahora que ambos grupos de idiomas están usando la nueva traducción del Misal con recursos actualizados, celebración de los Santos, cantos y oraciones, el FDLC quería compartir las enseñanzas básicas de Liturgia y Adoración. Los documentos del Concilio Vaticano II hasta ahora son los recursos utilizados para producir este Resumen. ¿Qué es la Liturgia?

Es domingo por la mañana. Nos levantamos, nos vestimos, reunimos a los niños, nos montamos en el auto y viajamos a nuestra parroquia. Nos acomodamos en nuestra banca favorita, decimos una breve oración en privado y nos ponemos de pie cuando llega el momento de cantar el canto de entrada. Seguimos la rutina normal. Cumplimos nuestra obligación fielmente. Pero, ¿qué ritual antiguo estamos iniciando? ¿En qué misterio portentoso hemos entrado?

La liturgia es el culto público oficial de la Iglesia. Nuestra liturgia más importante es la Misa, pero tenemos otras liturgias, como funerales, bendiciones, y todos los demás ritos sacramentales. La palabra liturgia viene del griego *leitourgia* - “el quehacer del pueblo.” De hecho, es la

Liturgy, by its very nature, is communal. We enter into relationship with the Trinity and with one another. We also enter into relationship with others all over the world who are gathering around the altar of Christ's word and Eucharist. The assembly is not a collection of people praying in the same place, but a community of people, who "express in their lives and manifest to others the mystery of Christ and the real nature of the church" (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, 2). And it is this mystery of Jesus Christ that is the only "theme" of any liturgy.

THE PASCHAL MYSTERY

The Paschal Mystery is the life, passion, death, resurrection and glorious ascension of Jesus Christ and our participation in it! Perhaps it's that second part that we least understand that "dying he destroyed our death and rising he restored our life" (Easter Preface I). Each liturgy, then, is a work of our ongoing redemption. We follow Christ's command to "do this in memory of me." But we do not simply remember what Jesus has done for us. With Christ as the head of every liturgical celebration, it is a remembering that makes present - *anamnesis*.

THE PRESENCE OF CHRIST

"To accomplish so great a work (our ongoing redemption) Christ is always present in his Church, especially at its liturgical celebrations" (SC 7). Christ is present not only in the person of his minister... but especially in his Eucharistic elements. He is present in the sacraments and in his word "for it is Christ himself who speaks when the holy Scriptures are read..." (CSL 7). Christ is present, too, in our assemblies, for he promised wherever two or more are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them" (Mt 18:20).

obra de Dios y nos invita a todos a participar en él (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, n. 1069).

La liturgia, por su propia naturaleza, es comunitaria. Entramos en relación con la Trinidad y unos con otros. También entramos en relación con otras personas por todo el mundo, que se reúnen en torno al altar de la palabra de Cristo y la Eucaristía. La asamblea no es un conjunto de personas que oran en el mismo lugar, sino una comunidad de personas que "expresan en sus vidas y manifiestan a los demás el misterio de Cristo y la naturaleza real de la iglesia" (Constitución sobre la sagrada Liturgia, n.2). Y es este misterio de Jesucristo lo que constituye el único "tema" de toda liturgia.

EL MISTERIO PASCUAL

El Misterio pascual es la vida, pasión, muerte, resurrección y gloriosa ascensión de Jesucristo y ¡nuestra participación en él! Quizá es esta segunda parte lo que menos comprendemos – que, "muriendo, destruyó nuestra muerte, y resucitando, restauró nuestra vida" (Prefacio de Pascua II). Cada liturgia, por tanto, es una obra de nuestra redención continua. Seguimos el mandamiento de Cristo de "hacer esto en memoria mía." Pero no solamente recordamos lo que Jesús ha hecho por nosotros. Con Cristo como cabeza de toda celebración litúrgica, es un recuerdo que se hace presente – *anamnesis*.

LA PRESENCIA DE CRISTO

"Para lograr tan gran obra [nuestra continua redención] Cristo siempre está presente en su Iglesia, especialmente en las celebraciones litúrgicas" (SC, 7). Cristo está presente no sólo en la persona de su ministro... sino especialmente en sus elementos Eucarísticos. Está presente en los sacramentos y en su palabra "porque es Cristo mismo quien habla cuando se leen las Escrituras..." (CSL, 7). Cristo está presente, también, en nuestras asambleas, ya que prometió que "donde dos o más se reúnen en mi nombre, allí estoy yo en medio de ellos" (Mt 18:20).



- Has someone mentioned to you that they feel overwhelmed by being a new mom or dad?


Elizabeth Ministry is held at the parish level. It can also be combined with other parishes in your grouping.




