
# Pentecost Novena / Novena de Pentecostés

## Novena to the Holy Spirit

To celebrate Pentecost, the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Church, we are going to pray the Holy Spirit Novena!

It is a powerful and moving noven that is meant to help us open ourselves up to the third person of the Holy Trinity. Even though we pray this noven as a preparation for the feast of Pentecost, you can also pray a novena to the Holy Spirit any time that you want. So, let us pray with great confidence and trust in our God who is all Good and Loving. Here are the novena prayers for the Novena to the Holy Spirit.

Each day begin: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.



#### Daily prayer (found in continuation after each day)

Each day you end with. Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth. O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations, through Christ Our Lord, Amen.

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Subject: Reopening Plan for St. Nicholas Church Amid COVID-19 Pandemic

Hello St. Nicholas Family,

I pray that you and your loved ones are healthy. As you may have seen, Cardinal Cupich recently shared our <u>multi-phased plan for reopening churches in the Archdiocese of Chicago.</u>

#### Specifically,

- Phase I allows for parishes to reopen for Baptism, Reconciliation, Weddings and Funerals with a limit of 10 attendees.
- Phase IA allows for parishes to reopen for private prayer and adoration with a limit of 10 attendees.
- Phase II allows for reopening for weekday and weekend Masses for larger groups depending on the guidelines from the state and the capacity of the church building.

First and foremost, it is important for everyone to understand that our efforts will prioritize the safety and well-being of all while maintaining due respect and reverence for the sacraments and liturgical norms of our faith.

We have assembled a Parish Reopening Leadership Team (RLT) with parishioners to lead our efforts. Together, we will attend required training from the Archdiocese to ensure that our parish reopening plan conforms to the guidelines developed by the Archdiocese in collaboration with civil and healthcare authorities.

A starter kit of protective and cleaning supplies, as well as, guidance on purchasing/maintaining supplies ongoing has been provided by the Archdiocese.

#### Timing for Our Reopening

The St. Nick RLT members and I will need to complete required training, which is taking place online this week. Once we complete the training, we will need to review and complete tasks assigned to all parishes as part of a reopening certification process for approval by the Archdiocese.

Following our training and certification approval, we will only open our church once St. Nick RLT and I feel confident that we have the right volunteers in place to make it possible to reopen. We will keep everyone informed as the plan progresses and guidelines are in place. A date for re-opening will be set once those are ready.

May God grant you His peace during this difficult time and may He manifest His love and presence to you in abundant ways. #### Específicamente,

- La Fase II permite la reapertura de Misas entre semana y fines de semana para grupos más grandes, según las pautas del estado y la capacidad del edificio de la iglesia.

En primer lugar, es importante que todos comprendan que nuestros esfuerzos priorizarán la seguridad y el bienestar de todos y al mismo tiempo mantendrán el debido respeto y reverencia por los sacramentos y las normas litúrgicas de nuestra fe.

Hemos reunido un Equipo de Liderazgo de Reapertura Parroquial (RTL) con feligreses para liderar nuestros esfuerzos. Juntos, asistiremos a la capacitación requerida de la Arquidiócesis para asegurar que nuestro plan de reapertura de la parroquia se ajuste a las pautas desarrolladas por la Arquidiócesis en colaboración con las autoridades civiles y de salud.

La Arquidiócesis ha proporcionado un kit de inicio de suministros de protección y limpieza, así como orientación sobre la compra/mantenimiento de suministros en curso.

Tiempo para nuestra reapertura

Los miembros de RTL de San Nicolás y yo tendremos que completar la capacitación requerida, que se llevará a cabo en línea esta semana. Una vez que completemos la capacitación, tendremos que revisar y completar las tareas asignadas a todas las parroquias como parte de un proceso de certificación de reapertura para su aprobación por la Arquidiócesis.

Después de nuestra aprobación de capacitación y certificación, solo abriremos nuestra iglesia cuando RTL San Nicolás y yo confiemos en que tenemos los voluntarios adecuados para hacer posible la reapertura. Mantendremos a todos informados a medida que avanza el plan y se establecen pautas. Se establecerá una fecha para la reapertura una vez que estén listas.

Que Dios les conceda Su paz durante este momento difícil y que Él les manifieste Su amor y presencia en formas abundantes.
