Vatican Explains Pope's Comments on Civil Unions

The Vatican's Secretary of State has asked papal representatives to share with bishops some clarifications regarding comments on civil unions made by Pope Francis in a recently released documentary, according to the apostolic nuncio to Mexico.

The clarifications explain that the pope's comments do not pertain to Catholic doctrine regarding the nature of marriage as a union between one man and one woman, but to provisions of civil law.

"Some statements, contained in the documentary 'Francisco' by screenwriter Evgeny Afineevsky, have provoked, in recent days, various reactions and interpretations. Therefore, some helpful points are offered, with the desire to present an adequate understanding of the Holy Father's words," Archbishop Franco Coppolo, apostolic nuncio, [posted on Facebook Oct. 30](#).

The nuncio told ACI Prensa, CNA's Spanish-language news partner, that the content of his post was provided by the Vatican Secretariat of State to apostolic nunciatures, in order to be shared with bishops.

The post explained that in a 2019 interview, unpublished parts of which were aired in the recent documentary, the pope commented at different times on two distinct issues: that children should not be ostracized from their families because of their sexual orientation, and on civil unions, amid discussion of a 2010 same-sex marriage bill in the Argentine legislature, which Pope Francis, who was then Archbishop of Buenos Aires, opposed.

The interview question that prompted remark on civil unions was "inherent in a local law from ten years ago in Argentina on 'equal marriages of same-sex couples' and the opposition of the then Archbishop of Buenos Aires in this regard. In this regard, Pope Francis has affirmed that 'it is an incongruity to speak of homosexual marriage,' adding that, in the same context, he had spoken of the right of these people to have certain legal coverage: 'what we have to do is a law of civil union; they have the right to be covered legally. I defended that,'" Coppolo posted on Facebook.

"The Holy Father had expressed himself thus during an interview in 2014: 'Marriage is between a man and a woman. The secular States want to justify civil unions to regulate various situations of coexistence, moved by the demand to regulate economic aspects between people, such as ensuring health care. These are coexistence pacts of a different nature, of which I would not be able to give a list of the different forms. It is necessary to see the various cases and evaluate them in their variety,' the post added.

Vatican Explains Pope's Comments on Civil Unions

El Secretario de Estado del Vaticano ha pedido a los representantes papales que compartan con los obispos algunas aclaraciones sobre los comentarios sobre uniones civiles hechos por el Papa Francisco en un documental recientemente publicado, según el nuncio apostólico en México.

Las aclaraciones explican que los comentarios del Papa no se refieren a la doctrina católica sobre la naturaleza del matrimonio como una unión entre un hombre y una mujer, sino a las disposiciones de la ley civil.

“Algunas declaraciones, contenidas en el documental 'Francisco' del guionista Evgeny Afineevsky, han provocado, en los últimos días, diversas reacciones e interpretaciones. Por lo tanto, se ofrecen algunos puntos útiles, con el deseo de presentar una comprensión adecuada de las palabras del Santo Padre”, publicó en Facebook el arzobispo Franco Coppolo, nuncio apostólico, el 30 de octubre.

El nuncio dijo a ACI Prensa, socio de noticias en español de la CNA, que el contenido de su publicación fue proporcionado por la Secretaría de Estado del Vaticano a las nunciaturas apostólicas, con el fin de compartirlo con los obispos.

La publicación explicaba que en una entrevista de 2019, de la cual se emitieron partes inéditas en el documental reciente, el Papa comentó en diferentes momentos sobre dos temas distintos: que los niños no deben ser excluidos de sus familias debido a su orientación sexual y las uniones civiles, en medio de la discusión de un proyecto de ley de 2010 sobre el matrimonio entre personas del mismo sexo en la legislatura argentina, al que se opuso el Papa Francisco, entonces arzobispo de Buenos Aires.

La pregunta de la entrevista que motivó el comentario sobre las uniones civiles era “inherente a una ley local de hace diez años en Argentina sobre ‘matrimonios iguales de parejas del mismo sexo’ y la oposición del entonces Arzobispo de Buenos Aires en este sentido. Al respecto, el Papa Francisco ha afirmado que ‘es una incongruencia hablar de matrimonio homosexual’, agregando que, en el mismo contexto, había hablado del derecho de estas personas a tener cierta cobertura legal: ‘lo que tenemos que hacer es una ley de unión civil; tienen derecho a estar cubiertos legalmente. Lo defendí’, publicó Coppolo en Facebook.


“El Santo Padre se había expresado así durante una entrevista en 2014: ‘El matrimonio es entre un hombre y una mujer. Los Estados laicos quieren justificar las uniones civiles para regular diversas situaciones de convivencia, movidas por la exigencia de regular aspectos económicos entre las personas, como asegurar la atención de la salud. Se trata de pactos de convivencia de distinta naturaleza, de los que no podría dar una relación de las distintas formas. Es necesario ver los diversos casos y evaluarlos en su variedad’”, agregó el post.






