Year of Mercy – Damian reported that Sue Garthwaite and Lois Shuford are preparing a series

Adult Faith Formation – Spanish -Recently Deacon Ivan Lazcano told Fr. Mike that he would be starting programs of Adult Faith Formation in Spanish. This was one of the goals that were developed in our 2013 Parish Transformation process. Jose Juan is very interested in this and would like to be involved. Fr. Mike will pursue this with Ivan.
